The FUSE Project is a cross-European consortium, made up of Rethink Ireland, Genio Trust (Ireland), Cohesion and Development Agency (Portugal), Portugal Social Innovation and Mission Unit, The Change Foundation (Bulgaria), BCause Foundation (Bulgaria), Cleantech (Bulgaria), Bulgarian Center for Not-for-Profit Law, The Business Institute (Bulgaria), the SYNTHESIS Center for Research and Education (Cyprus), and the Centre for Social Innovation (Cyprus).</p> <p>The FUSE Project is a consortium which uses transnational cooperation and shared learning at its heart for the establishment of National Competences Centres for Social Innovation (NCCSIs). SIS Credit was established in 2006 and is one of the leading microfinance institutions in Bulgaria. The company is supervised by the Bulgarian National Bank in accordance with the Law governing credit institutions in Bulgaria and is connected to the Bulgarian credit bureau. SIS Credit is part of financial group SIS. SIS Credit mission is to support the preservation of existing jobs and the creation of new ones in Bulgaria by understanding the needs of its clients that is entrepreneurs, micro and small businesses and providing them tailor-made products and services in a fast and effective manner. SIS Credit is among the first European institutions that signed the European Code of Good Conduct for Microcredit Provision launched by the European Commission. In 2018 the institution		

was certified for 94% compliance with The Code. In 2021 SIS Credit was reassessed by passing with 95%.

SIS Credit is committed to the support of entrepreneurs, especially the ones under 29- years old and the ones with disabilities. In December 2017 SIS has been selected as a partner of Fund manager of financial instruments in Bulgaria under the Risk Sharing Micro-Finance Facility under Operational program Human resource development, co-financed by ESF+. Total amount of the project amounts EUR 900 000 and as of March 2019 29 entrepreneurs have already received low-interest funding and professional advice. The instrument provides support to start-ups and social enterprises, as well as those set up by people who have been unemployed for more than 6 months, people with disabilities and young people aged 29 or less. In June 2019 SIS Credit signed another contract to disburse additional EUR 1.47 M under the second phase of the instrument and additional EUR 350 000 funding was approved in 2022.

BDB Microfinancing was created in 2011 as a part of the Group of the Bulgarian Development Bank. Its main purpose is to facilitate the access to financing of the micro- and small businesses, agricultural producers, freelancers, craftsmen and others who develop or start new business on the territory of the country. The main purpose is a long-term provision of financial services to the micro- and small enterprises. In this way BDB Microfinancing:

- improves their access to financial services,
- contributes to the creating and retaining of workplaces,
- reduces their “exclusion” from the market of financial services,
- helps the target groups to develop their own business ideas.

BDB Microfinancing introduces a new program to support SMEs, start-ups and social businesses. The program is in partnership with the Fund Manager of Financial Instruments in Bulgaria and aims to promote entrepreneurship among vulnerable groups. It will enable businesses to access credit resources on easy terms at 25% lower interest rates than the standard rates of the financial institution. The resource is under the Operational Program "Human Resources Development 2014-2020" (OPHRD), co-financed by the European Social Fund.
