Background

Central Asian Microfinance Alliance was founded by four Central Asian microfinance associations of Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan in 2022. The Alliance was created to act as a regional knowledge hub in the field of microfinance. Among the initial initiatives, there are the topics of increasing financial inclusion, supporting women's entrepreneurship, introduction of ESG standards.

Background of the regional summit

The Alliance has been organizing the annual Central Asian Microfinance Summit since 2022. The summit aims to coordinate microfinance development initiatives in the region, share best practice, bring new products and services to the market, discuss potential risks, communicate with regulators, attract investment, promote digital solutions, and reward those who have contributed to the development of the industry.

Expected participants of the regional summit

200 participants are expected to participate in the summit. Including representatives of Central banks of Central Asia, leading development financial institutions active in the region, heads of associations, microfinance organizations, Microfinance Center (MFC), software and FinTech organizations, investors and others.

- Attract investment to Central Asian microfinance markets.
- Promote Gender-Inclusive Microfinance Products.
- Advance Climate Adaptation through Microfinance.

- Enhance Knowledge Sharing and Collaboration.
- Develop Capacity Building Initiatives.
